"Fell To His Death" - "Roger Willard, of Samaria, Stricken by Paralysis
 and Falls From Load of Wood" - "When news reached the city early in the
 week that Roger Willard had died Saturday evening at his home in Samaria,
 it sent a pang through the hearts of hundreds of citizens and the
 spreading of the sad tidings will cause much genuine sorrow to his legion
 of friends throughout the country. His death was sudden and unusually
 sad, which accentuates the mournful features of his demise."

"Mr. Willard conducted a store in Samaria and about a mile west of
 there owned a snug little farm of forty acres. To this he went last
 Thursday to get a load of wood. He failed to return in due season, but,
 as he had said that he might go to Mr. Powsland on business, his family,
 while a little anxious, did not become alarmed."

"In the meantime a son of Lou is Bookey, whose farm adjoins the Willard
 farm, noticed that Mr. Willard's team and load of wood had stood in the

same place for several hours and that the horses, affected by the cold, had become restless and were rearing and plunging though not making any advances. Suspecting something might be amiss, he went to investigate and to his horror discovered Mr. Willard in a crouching attitude, on his knees, with hands and blankets pressed against his face. A glance showed that he had fallen from the load, his face, nose and forehead being badly bruised and the eyes blackened. The reins were under the horses and judging from the way the team stood so long, he must have shouted 'Whoa' as he fell. Mr. Willard was unconscious and young Bookey could not raise him. He therefore called his father and the unfortunate man was taken by them to the Bookey house. Mrs. Willard and a doctor were at once sent for, the latter pronouncing paralysis as the cause of the fall. Mr. Willard lingered until 9:15 Saturday evening, without, however, regaining consciousness. The spot where he fell was some distance from the road, so that passers by did not notice him."

"Funeral services were held Tuesday at eleven o'clock from the Evangelical church according to Masonic rites, and the remains interned in Union Cemetery. The funeral cortege was one of the longest ever held in that portion of the country."

"Mr. Willard was born in Ida November 27, 1839, and had thus almost attained the age of 64. He was the last of the direct descendants of the old Willard family. He leaves a wife and six children to mourn him. They are: Allen, a grocer in Toledo; Eugene, in the immigrants' office at New York City; Clarence, of Delta, O., a conductor on the Toledo & Western electric line; Mrs. George J. Eisenmann of Samaria; Mrs. Jacob Moyer of Washington, D. C.; and Frances at home."

"Mr. Willard was one of the squarest and most upright men and his friends and acquaintances vie with each other in paying tribute to his excellent qualities. As a friend, as neighbor, as business man, as public officer, his character and reput

HISTORY OF MONROE COUNTY, MICHIGAN

"Solomon Ansted, one of the well known and highly respected citizens of Bedford township, Monroe county, Mich igan, while he has been a resident of this locality since he was five years o ld, claims the "Buckeye State" as the one of his nativity. It was in Wood co unty, Ohio, July 29, 1859, that he was born, son of Jacob and Elizabeth (Welk er) Ansted, both of German birth. The grandparents of Mr. Ansted, both pater nal and maternal, emigrated to this country with their respective families an d settled in Ohio, and it was there that Jacob Ansted and his wife met and were married. They spent their wedded life in Wood county, and after his de ath, which occurred there, the widowed mother came with her children to Michi gan and established a home in Monroe county. Here the mother died in 1904 and following is her obituary. "

"Elizabeth Welker was born at Darmstadt, Germany , Interment was made in the Hitchcock Cemetery." (See obit in Eliza beth Welker data)

"In the district schools of Bedford township Solomon Ansted laid the foundation for that broader education which he has gained in the sch ool of experience. From the time he was seventeen until 1896, covering a p eriod of twenty years, he devoted his energies to farming. Then he engaged i n the hardware, implement and furniture business at Temperance, and successfu lly conducted the same until he sold out in 1906. The next three years he re presented the Internal Harvester Company. The farm, however, held its attrac tions, and again we find him engaged in agricultural pursuits. He owns fifty acres of land where he lives, in Bedford township, and twenty-two acres a mi le south of this tract. Besides this, he has other real estate interests, inc luding a house and lot in Toledo, Ohio, and a cottage and several lots at Tol edo Beach."

"December 25, 1883, Mr. Ansted and Miss Emma Butler, a native of Bedford township, were united in marriage. Mrs. Ansted was born February 24 , 1866, and is the third in a family of five children, four sons and

one daughter born to John A. and Calista (Belman) Butler. There are three of the children yet living; eldest is Chas. A., resident of Temperance, Michigan, educated in common schools and is married. Mrs. Ansted is next. Richard A., resident of Toledo, Ohio, is a carpenter and joiner. he is married. John A. Butler is a resident of Temperance, Michigan. He was a soldier in the Civil war, and was a carpenter by trade in years past. his wife is a native of Ohio and both are members of the Baptist church."

"Mrs. Solomon Ansted was educated in the common schools and she is a lady of pleasing address and personality, and has been her husband's counselor and aid in life's work. Mr. and Mrs. Ansted have four children; the eldest is Ernest J., a resident of Toledo, Ohio and is now a salesman for an automobile company; he was reared on his father's farm and educated in the common schools. He wedded Miss Carrie Grostenfaine, and they have three children: Kenneth B., in school; Paul D. and Gilbert R."

"Gertrude M. wedded J. Arthur Rowland, and they have two children, Floyd Lucild and Grace Elenore. Mr. Rowland is a Republican and a traveling salesman."

"Hanford S. B. completed the public schools and is now in the third year of the Toledo high school."

"Beulah Ferne is in the public schools and has taken some musical training. Mrs. Ansted is a member of the Woman's Christian Temperance Union, as is also her husband."

"Mr. Ansted is a member of the Free Methodist church at Temperance, of which is a trustee, and an active worker. He takes little interest in politics more than to vote a straight Republican ticket."
