John Proctor was really a nice person until he became drunk and then he was mean and abusive had tried to stab her with a butcher knife once and another time he nearly broke her back when he tried to get to baby Charlie who had colic and was screaming and crying. She divorced him

Being a divorcee at the turn of the century was very hard as the public looked down on divorce even Though she or the baby may have been killed.

Claire knew him, liked him as a person, and when he died Claire held his funeral service and had him buried.

She was a teacher at the Bethel Seven Day Adventist Church School, where her children received their education. (She was a vegetarian)

She went to Chattanooga, Tn, to the Academy and taught school there too, and later years she taught school in a very small building on the property of her daughter Eva's. (10 or 12 ft sq perhaps.)

Ada was a tiny little lady, well mannered, later years she had pure white hair which laid back from her face in waves back into a small knot at the base of her neck.

Her nickname was "Little Susie"

She is buried in a large cemetery across from the National Cemetery in Nashville, Tn, next to her daughter Eva, They have a common tombstone shaped in the form of a heart.

She relayed info to Dorothy Adella Hughes that " and you are related to Betsy Batong???? Haven't found her yet in 1999.

His Letter of Intention -"page #365 Naturalization in Dane Co. Madison, Wi. to the Honorable Judge of the Seventh Judicial Circuit, The Petition of Arthur G. Hughes, native of England, respectfully sheweth that your petitioner is about 55 years of age; It also says he entered United States into the port of Portland Me. That he emigrated and arrived in the United States, to-wit: at the port of entry of Portland, Me in the month of January A.D. 1871, and that, in pursuance of an Act of Congress entitled An act to establish an uniform rule of Naturalization, and to repeal the acts here to fore passed on that subject, made a declaration of his intention to become a citizen, and a report and registry of his nativity, age allegiance, emigration and arrival in the United States. conformably to the said act," " Before the Circuit Court , for the County of Dane State of Wis. on the 21st day of October A.D. 1884 a certificate whereof is here unto annexed; and that he has resided within the limits , and under the jurisdiction of the United States for five years last past, and for one year within the State of Wisconsin; that he has never borne and hereditary title or been of any of the orders of nobility of the kingdom whence he came or elsewhere. He therefore prays he may be admittted to become a citizen of the United States. Waupaca County Circuit Citizens S.W. Bently and A.L. Randall Sworn in open court before me this 1st day of November A.D. 1901 that they are acquainted with the above petitioner etc. I, Arthur G. Hughes the above named petitioner, do, on my solemn oath declare that the contents of my petition are true; that I will support the Constitution of the United States; that I do renounce and relinquish any title or order of nobility to which I am or hereafter may be entitled; and I do absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State and Sovereignty whatever. and particularly to the Goot of Great Britian of whom I was before a subject Sworn in open Court, before me this day 1st day of Nov 1884, Arthur Galt Hughes". Thirteen years lost between 1871 and 1884.(?May be in Rock Co, Wi) (Was he a resident of Waupaca Co ? in 1900?)

He had 2 brothers Hesketh b 1853 and Albert b 1862, He had 6 sisters Emma b 1842, Margaret b 1850, Letitia b 1852, Florence b 1856, Caroline b 1858, and Edith b 1860 (whom he referred to as little Eddie with affection, she would have been abt 11 yrs of age when he left London, Jan 1871)

It is not known why he left London and his family, it seems that he was in some kind of trouble at that time, his

family gave him his share of the family money and jewels. He lived in a mansion called Cripple Creek (or Kripple Kit or Kipple Kit ?)

His ancestors were Lace makers for Queen Victoria, His father worked as Japan Tinplate worker

He built a factory of his own invention, making shipping boxes, and was very successful. However his competitors burned him out, no insurance. devastated he left with his 1st child pregnant wife Olive Stephens. They moved by Train Box car headed new home, when she went into premature labor, both she and Arthur left the Train, he stayed with her, she died and the baby too. He was crushed, no home, no business, no wife or child. When he did get to the Train his possessions had been stolen. Many times he spoke of his Love of Olive to Claire.

He became a rural Mail Carrier out of Arpin, Wood Co, Wi into the Bethel, Wood Co, Wi area. At that time they hung a bag on a post near the home of the party with their mail in it.

Arthur Galt Hughes had a beautiful Baritone voice, very resonate, his voice could be heard nearly a mile away as he delivered his mail. (While in England he sang in the Saint Paul's Cathedral, and in the Kings Court.) He delivered mail over corduroy roads. made by laying tree logs from one side of the road to the other, one after another to keep above the muddy muck that made it impossible to drive his horse and buggy across.

His step children did not respect him! His English speech and mannorisms were different from theirs, His manner was quite formal, and they resisted him. (His step brother's wife Nina has said he was truly an English Gentleman), Later Eva was so sorry, she told me (Dorothy) that there was so much he was willing to teach them, he tried so hard and it only made worse treatment for him, she was sorry that she didn't let him share the wonderful knowledge his had with her.

He was a Master at growing things like fruit trees, vegetables and strawberries. His stepson Charley took his plow and pulled out some trees and his garden while he was on his mail route, as one of his pranks.

Another problem was Charley stole a model of one of his inventions, he sold it ! Later years Claire saw it in the basement of Charley's home.

(With the later information I believe Arthur Galt Hughes came in the port of Portland Maine and went directly to Rock Co. Wi. or perhaps even to Dane Co. Wis. Built his factory in Rock Co. and married Olive Stephens, his factory was burned out and I believe they moved perhaps to Waupaca Co and on the way Olive went into labor ,

died as well as their baby. I believe he stayed in Waupaca Co for some time. Don't know how he met Ada Melvina (Dow) Proctor (divorced from John Proctor) (I also believe he was sick from either Alzheimers or Parkinson's disease, as he lost his senses of the neat, intelligent man and was found walking outside his home without clothing, when Claire was notified and went to place him in hospital in Marshfield, Wi.) He had a very bad Hernia that would pop out,

His father Levi and Mahala Dickinson moved to Wisconsin, leaving the Book of Dow records stating - "moved about 65 years ago to Wis. lost sight of."

Our family has stories about him.

He was the Mayor of Ogdensburg, Waupaca, Wi., lived on a farm with livestock, lived his life as a gentle person. During the Flu epidemic when many local residents died, including the parents of a little girl which he took into his home to raise with his children. They were a Catholic family, the Priest in those days went into the homes and taught catismum

When he came into his home the little girl was lonely and frightened and did not respond to him as he would like, The Priest struck her, when Andrew witnessed this he told the Priest never to lay a hand on her again or he would strike him. The Priest showed his authority by striking the poor little girl again. Andrew kept his word by hitting him so hard it knocked out some of his teeth. As the Priest quickly left he cursed Andrews Potato crop, and ordered him out of the church. Well that year Andrew had the very best Potato crop ever and when he saw the Priest on the street one day he invited him to come back the next year. and curse his crops again.

He had a Livery Stable was quite well off.

He is buried at Ogdenburg per Aunt Nina. Phebe and her sister Mae is buried ther also

He also lived in Freemont, Wyewega, Sheridan. Grandma Hughes sister married a Whitney and they lived on a farm at Sheridan.

New Brunswick area , we visited several cemeteries (8 in one day) We found cousins, and other Dickinsons. We found that the area had very few people in the area for many years and that the families intermarried, Dickinson and Dow families, so the 1st thing I did was to check our family line for that and did not find any at this time.

Roberta Florence (Hughes- Root) McBurney and Dorothy Adella (Hughes- Cogdill - Waterhouse) Kratzer spent a full day in the Fredericton, New Brunswick, Canada Archives looking for this line of the family. It may be we found it, however proof is lacking. The family is evident, however the line is vague.

Whitney Family-"Micah Whitney, the first to come was John Whitney who settled in Watertown, mass in 1635. (says of Flemish origin). All , or nearly all, of the Whitneys in Maine were descendants of the Massachusetts immigrant, and he was the progenitor of a numerous family. No less than ten families settled in Phillips, Maine, and in the towns near between 1792 and 1815. Most of these families did not think they were related. It is now known that they were all descendants of the Massachusetts immigrant. Jacob Whitney, a Revolutionary soldier, was the first town clerk of Phillips when the town was organized in 1812. He was living in Phillips as early as 1793, and his son Christopher must have been about the first white child in Phillips. In the census of 1790, the first census taken in the United States, there were no families living in Phillips, but fourteen families were living in Avon, an adjoining town. In 1791 seven men came to Phillips and made clearings and built log homes. Sherman S. Whitney, a merchant in Phillips (1943), is a great-grandson of the above mentioned Jacob Whitney. He was 1st in service in the Indian campaign of 1746 under Capt. John Goffe at Dover; 1758 enlisted as private, Capt. John Hazzens, against Ticonderoga and distinguished himself at Crown Point. He gained a Lieut's commission from the Crown.

He was one of the many who expected the Revolution and prepared for it financially and otherwise. He took Captaincy, serving and instructing recruits at Great Island from Nov 5, 1775. In this company were ensign Jeremiah Dow bedbed, his own son Asa as Sgt, Percy Dow bedbad, fifer, and Isaac Dow private Identity uncertain. Altho 70 yrs of age Richard advanced all his money to the town to pay soldier bounties and equip troops, and was appointed to raise a new company for service in N.Y. State. This company was assigned to the regiment of Col. Nathan Hale of Coventry, Conn.
