Reportedly had a sister named Lucy Mosley who married a Jim Osborne (Ausbin) and a brother James Mosley. Here's the information on her children:

(1) 1900 - lived in Cutshin, Leslie County, Kentucky as a servant in the home of Felix and Nancy Turner. Had a child by Felix, Chester Turner b. 1902 in Pine Mountaint, Kentucky. Chester married Martha Curry in Harlan County, Kentucky and resided there and had numerous

children.

(2) abt 1902 - Napier, Leslie County, Kentucky - had child Bradley, by Henry Maggard. Henry married Matilda Turner and they resided in Harlan County, Kentucky and had several children. Bradley married in Harlan County, moved to Tennessee and had several children.

(3) 1904 - Kentucky - had child Lucy reported by Dave Osborne (Ausbin). Dave was reportedly a married Baptist Minister and denied Lucy when she tried to meet him. He apparently died in a housefire but not sure of date / location. Lucy married Bill West and resided in Tazewell, Claiborne County, Tennessee and had 3 children.

(5) 1910 - Claiborne County, Tennessee - in census as servant in the home of Thomas Kekky (he had sons Ben and Tilmon at home). Her 2 daughters are there with her but the sons are resided with their fathers.

(6) 1912 - near Fugate, Claiborne, Tennessee - had child, Bertha, by Ben Kelly. Bertha married W.G. West and moved to Morristown, Tennessee. She had 3 children.

(7) 1916 - Tennessee - had son, Willie, by Burl Jennings. Willie lived with her for one year, then lived with the Hammocks (sp?) of Gibson Station, Virginia. Was adopted about age 5 by James Kelly and Polly Jane Fee of Caylor, Virginia. Willie married and moved to Kentucky, Ohio, and then Oak Ridge, Tennessee where he died. He had several children.

1917 - Rose Hill, Lee County, Virginia Jane reportedly died of pneumonia, typhoid fever but cannot find burial or death certificate. Family reports she was buried in this area. Name may have been Jane Kelly plus complicating matters is that she reportedly lived with Burl Jennings at this time.

1920 - no documentation of Jane found. Her 3 daughters are living as foster children in the home of Ben Kelly and his sister Mary Saliner.

Name Prefix: Reverend

According to Oscar Phillips, Moses had a one third interest in 13, 000 acres of mountain land. In the 1970's his heirs were involved in litigation against the land companies, who they believed had stolen part of the land which Moses had left to his heirs when he died. Moses was a private in the G Co, 7th Mounted Infantry in the Union Army in the Civil War. He served from Nov. 8, 1864 to July 27, 1865. He was a minister, and served as pastor of Beechfork Baptist Church, and on the 30th day of August 1873, he and Rev. Sterling Adkins organized a church by the name of Pleasant Rest Church at Nicks Creek on the New River. The church was later named Nicks Creek Missionary Baptist Church. Moses Phillips built a log house at the 2300 feet level on the Anderson side of Red Oak Mountain. It is near Red Oak Gap Church. His children and grandchildren lived in the house. His son, Boomer Jim, is buried in a family cemetery near the house site.

Notes for John Benjamin Maggard:

John was born in Lower District, Russell now Scott County, Virginia. He was a Gunsmith, Blacksmith and a Farmer. He found the silver he used in his guns in the Leslie County mountains. He made 'hog rifles'. The gun was marked with his initials, J.B.M. Even today there may be one or more gund made by him among the treasures of the mountain people.

Sarah was born near what was then Rocky Mount, the 1st capital (1790-1792) of The Territory of the United States South of the River Ohio in Carter County, Tennessee what is now near Johnson City to Moses Adams and Mary Garland. They area was settled in the 1780's.

They moved to Cutshin Creek in 1847 among the first settlers in what is now Leslie County, built a large log house near his parents' home. Both died in Leslie County, Kentucky.

He and wife Sarah Adams lived in Letcher County thirty-nine years. They had twelve children. In 1847 John and Sarah moved to unsettled Leslie County. They settled on Cutshin Creek. They were among the first settlers in what is now Leslie County.

NEW RIVER SETTLERS BY; WILLIAM JASPER SMITH

ISAAC PHILLIPS, THE FATHER OF ALL THE PHILLIPS, SETTLED ON NEW RIVER OVER 100 YEARS AGO. HE BUILT A LOG HOUSE JUST BELOW ELIJAH'S CREEK. HE CAME FROM HAYWOOD COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA TO ANDERSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE. HE REARED FOUR BOYS, TOM, ISAAC, JAMES AND CHARLES. THERE IS A HOST OF HIS RELATIVES STILL LIVING THERE. I DON'T KNOW WHAT NATIONALITY THEY WERE, BUT THEY SPOKE A BROKEN LANGUAGE. THEY WERE A PECULIAR PEOPLE, BUT CLEVER. THEY LOVED THEIR WHISKEY AND IT WAS A COMMON DRINK THEN. A QUART BOTTLE SET ON THE DINING TABLE AND A WOODEN BOWL AND SPOON. PREACHERS DIDN'T THINK IT WAS WRONG TO TAKE A SUP.

ISAAC WOULD HIDE HIS MONEY, GOLD AND SILVER WAS THE CURRENCY THEN. HE GOT HOLD OF NANCY'S, HIS WIFE'S OLD STOCKING ONE DAY AND PUT MONEY IN IT AND PUT IT IN THE CELLAR. HIS WIFE WENT DOWN IN THE CELLAR TO GET SOME POTATOES. HE PEEPED THROUGH A CRACK TO SEE IF SHE FOUND IT AND SHE DID, SHE COULD HARDLY MOVE IT. HE TOLD HER NOT TO BRING IT UP THERE HE DIDN'T NEED THE BEGGARS TO SEE IT, THAT HE WOULD MOVE IT. HE WOULD GET DRUNK AND PUT HIS FINGERS IN HIS EARS AND SAY, OLD IKE WILL DIE IN THE MOUNTAINS. AT THE CLOSE OF THE CIVIL WAR HE DIED IN THE OLD LOG HOUSE HE BUILT IN HIS EARLY DAYS. HE HID ALL HIS MONEY SOMEWHERE ON THE CREEK AND IT HAS NEVER BEEN FOUND.

MY FATHER WENT TO BORROW SOME MONEY FROM HIM, KNOWING THAT HE LOVED HIS DRAM, HE TOOK A QUART OF BRANDY WITH HIM. IT WAS WINTER AND MY FATHER GOT COLD RIDING ACROSS THE MOUNTAIN. HE HITCHED UP HIS HOSE AND WENT IN. IKE WAS IN ONE CORNER AND HIS WIFE WAS IN THE OTHER. HE DREW UP A STOOL AND SAT DOWN, WHEN HE GOT WARM HE TOLD IKE HIS BUSINESS. HE SAID I HAVEN'T GOT IT. MY FATHER PULLED OUT HIS BRANDY AND IKE TOOK SEVERAL DRINKS AND BEGIN SINGING. HE TOLD HIS WIFE TO SEE IF SHE COULD FIND BILL ANY MONEY. SHE WENT BACK IN THE OTHER END OF THE HOUSE AND KNOCKED A PIN OUT OF THE SIDE OF THE WALL. Notes for Samuel Maggard:

Samuel was born in Botetourt, what now is Rockbridge County, Virginia located in the Shenandoah Valley and he died in Letcher County, Kentucky.

Samuel was a farmer by trade as well as a Pastor at Oven Fork Church from 1849 until just shortly before his death. The cause of death was listed as "old age" he was 79 years old. He was 15 years old when George Washington was elected our 1st president.

Rebecca was born in Russell now Scott County, Virginia and died in Letcher County, Kentucky. She died a few years before Samuel as he was listed as a widower on his death certificate.

Soon after their marriage, in 1795 with the money they made selling off land they were given by their British Employer, they joined a wagon train and came to Kentucky. The trip was long and hazardous and they endured many hardships. They stopped at the head of the Cumberland to repair some wagons, Samuel saw the fertile, clear streams filled with fish, and plenty of wild game. He stopped in what is now Letcher County and built a large log house. A year later, John was born and in 1798 they became the parents of a daughter, Susanna who would later marry Henry Bach Jr. Samuel was 22yrs and Rebecca was 18yrs when they had their first child.

They are both buried in the "Maggard Cemetery" located in Whitesburg, Kentucky which was also formed at the same time of the county and is located on the North Fork of the Kentucky River. Letcher County was formed in 1842 from portions of Harlan and Perry counties and is located in the eastern coal field region of the state.

Old Mose, the last of the Maggard Slaves traveled with Sam and Rebecca from Virginia to Kentucky where he lived out his life as an endeared family member.

At this point the family name has gone through changes in spelling as well as pronunciation. Mägert to Maggart to Maggard, which is the current spelling to this day.

On the back of a picture of his grandson, "Uncle" Dave Maggard, Baptist Preacher, is written that Samuel came from the German area of Switzerland, and Rebecca was from Ireland.

The Maggards are of Swiss/German origin. Hans and his brother left from northern Germany to America in early 1700 when they were in their late teens. Hans settled first in Pennsylvania, (per agreement circa 1620, Virginia was considered an authorized area to be settled), then going into Augusta, now Rockingham County, Virginia. As a surveyor and road builder, he found the land around the Shenandoah River very rich. He went back to Pennsylvania and brought his family to the Shenandoah Valley of Virginia. He had a large plantation on which he raised wheat and livestock.
