There is a great deal of hand written land grants at Virginia Land Office Patents & Grants/Northern Neck Grants & Surveys. Much can be found at the Mary Ball Washington Library and St. Mary's White Chapel Church. They consider Ball descendents to be royalty.

John Milton Glascock purchased two "Pre-emption" Land Patents from the Cahaba Land Office (sequential certificates #5980 & 5982 dated 1 June, 1831). John M. is specifically identified as "Senr." on these grants. These are for 80 acres (E1/2 of SW 1/4, Sec. 20, T17, R5) which is now in the extreme North East corner of Marengo Co. and 80 acres (E1/2 of SE 1/4, Sec. 34, T22, R12) which is now in far West Chilton Co. on the Bibb Co. line. The term "pre-emption" indicates that the purchaser was living (squatting) on the land prior to the time of the survey and was thus granted priority in purchasing. The two tracts were 51 miles apart (as the crow flies).

Aaron, Sr.'s' daughter, Martha married James Glasscock.

In the 1830 census micro film Bibb Co. Alabama, James Glasscock 0021001 0100001, page 283. This shows both to be in their 40's. In the 1850 Marion County, AL census she was 66 and in the 1860 Marion County, AL census she was 73. (I am assuming, the Martha living with Jas. H. Glasscock in the Marion County, AL census was his mother, Martha Campbell Glasscock.) Which means she would have been born in the 1780s & probably between 1784-1787. Therefore Aaron, Sr. must have been born circa 1768-1771 assuming Martha was his first born, however I have Robert David Campbell being eldest b' circa 1780, this would push Aaron Sr.'s' birth to 1766 or before.

1825 Bibb County Alabama Commissioner Court Minutes - found by John D. Glasscock (E-mail: jondavid@hiwaay.net (John D. Glasscock) 12095 County Road 51, Jemison, AL 35085, phone 205.688.4343. He descends from John Milton Glasscock, Jr.) : "Ordered that James Glascock, Thomas Glascock, Calvin Glascock, John Milton Glascock, Jr., Aaron Campbell, Alexander Wilson pay quarter yearly on the first of January, April, July, and October to the overseer of the Poor in Capt. Benjamin M. Reynolds Militia Company the sum of three dollars each to be applied by the said overseer of the poor and his successors for the support and maintenance of John M. Glascock, Snr., father of the said James, Thomas, Calvin and John M. Glascock and father in law of the said Aaron Campbell and Alexander Wilson."

In 1830 there is a female age 50/60 living with them. I believe this is Aaron's mother, Lydia.

In the 1840 census there is a male 20-30 yrs. old living with them. Is this another son? Would have been born 1810-1820.

Aaron and Martha were among the first settlers into the Mulberry settlement in Bibb Co. AL. They were among the group who organized the Mulberry Church.

Aaron Jr. could have been in the War of 1812 at age 16. He was probably given a land grant of approx. 476 acres in Bibb Co., AL by the government. This land is mentioned in Patsy Campbell's Will.

3 Campbell's appear in Bibb County by 1825, Aaron, David (and Charity) and Elijah (and Lizzie Kemp).

There were two Elijahs in Bibb Co. One I have listed as Aaron and Patsy Glascock Campbell's son who died 10 Oct 1843. The other is from a census for 1850 Bibb Co., AL. They were not the same Elijahs, obviously. Early history of Bibb Co. said there were three Campbells in Bibb Co by 1825, Aaron, David (and Charity), and Elijah (and Lizzie Kemp). This Elijah was probably the son of Aaron Campbell Jr. The second Elijah I found in the 1850 Bibb Co, AL census was married to Caroline, and all his kids had names which were repeated in the Campbell line. Aaron Jr's Will does not mention an Elijah (who was already dead at the time) nor Elijah's children, which makes me think Elijah #2 was not Elijah #1's son. (Martha Cross Mordecai, 2003)

There was a Henry Campbell listed in either VA or NC who was married to Charity LNU. He was also possibly a family member.

"The Bibb Co. book by Abrams states that the father of Aaron is David Campbell and wife Charity, David most certainly is the brother to Aaron. Aaron's Will filed in Bibb Co. Alabama.

I Aron Campbell of the State and County aforesaid being of sound disposing mind and memory do make ordain and publish this to be my Last Will and Testament hereby revoking and making void all other wills by me at any time heretofore made.

1st I give and bequeath to my daughter Elmina Davenport, wife of Wilson Davenport, one feather bed and furniture, one cow and calf, one sow and pigs and other household furniture at the value of one hundred dollars which I delivered to her at her marriage.

2nd I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Cobb wife of James Cobb one feather bed and furniture and other household furniture, one cow and calf, one sow and pigs valued at one hundred dollars which I delivered to her at her marriage.

3rd I give and bequeath to my son Alva Campbell two horses one feather bed and furniture and one cow and calf valued at one hundred and eighty dollars which I have delivered to him at and before his marriage.

4th I give and bequeath to my daughter Millissa [?] one feather bed and furniture, one cow and calf to be delivered to her at my death.

5th I give and bequeath to William Young Nix son of my deceased daughter Melena Nix one hundred dollars in money to remain in the hands of my Executrix and to be managed for the said William Young Nix by my Executrix during her life time or until the said William Young Nix arrives at the age of Twenty years old.

My said Executrix paying as accounting to the said William young Nix for the annual Interest on the said one hundred dollars at the rate of eight percent the interest commencing on the first day of January next proceeding

the probate of this will -

6th I give and bequeath to my daughter Malona Rasberry wife of William Rasberry one feather bed and furniture and other household furniture and one cow and calf valued at sixty dollars which I delivered to her at her marriage.

7th I give and bequeath to my son Lawson one chesnut sorrell horse which I have delivered valued at forty dollars, and at his marriage I will that he has one feather bed and furniture one cow and calf to be delivered to him by my Executrix

8th I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Martha Campbell all the rest and residue of my property both real and personal or [?] My real estate consisting of about four hundred and thirty acres and the following negro slaves - Letty Soe Mallison , Otisia Bedy Phivaley, John Andrew Printick, Margaret Turner, Mary Jane and her two children Balm and M[?] Harriet Mariah and Lawrance and all my horses hogs cattle sheep goats and household and kitchen furniture and all the farming tools and implements of husbandry to have and to hold the said negroes with the future increase of the familys thereof and real estate of her own use and benefit during her natural life and that my said wife Martha Campbell is authorized to dispose of said property by grant deed, will, sale or otherwise as she may think proper and her title to the same shall be good so far as she may sell or dispose of any of the property to any other person after my decease.

9th I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my wife Martha Campbell my sole Executrix of this my last will and testament in witness where of I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 4th day of July AD 1857'.

"All Aaron's living daughters and their husbands contested the will and requested a jury to adjudicate. On the day set for the hearing, William Green Rasberry and his wife, Malonia Astoria Campbell Rasberry, requested that their names be removed as contestants to the will. This request was granted. The will stood as valid and the other sisters and their husbands had to pay all court costs."

"Martha Patsy Glascock Campbell, the widow of Aaron, left her property equally to the elder of two sons and the oldest two daughters.

It has been handed down through the family that Patsy Glascock Campbell told her progeny that they were of the Argyll Branch of the Campbell Clan."

There was an article in Birmingham News in June 1992 regarding Senator Shelby's return to the Cobb Confederate Cemetery. This reunion takes place every year on the weekend closest to the anniversary of James Cobb's death.

Location of Cobb Confederate Cemetery: In Alabama between Montgomery and Birmingham off I-65 Jemison Exit to downtown Jemison (Chilton Co.), ... come to Municipal Bldg. on perpendicular street, ... turn right. Drive to the High School (on left) turn right on County Rd. 51. Go all the way (abt. 3 or 4 miles) until you cross over I-65. Turn left almost immediately onto a dirt road. Follow dirt road about 2 miles. At the end of the road on a hill to the right is the old cemetery. It is surrounded by a wrought iron fence. The gate opens, as there is no lock.

Bibb County: was originally created as Cahawba County by the Alabama Territorial Legislature on 1818 Feb. 7. Alterations were made to the boundaries in 1818, 1819, 1820, 1821 and 1867. The county name was changed to Bibb on Dec. 4, 1820, in honor of Alabama's first governor, William Wyatt Bibb.

When he would pass the old house during the daytime on his train, he would always blow the horn so we could run to the window and wave. We would almost break our necks running through the house to wave and blow a kiss to him before he passed out of sight.

I am not sure where my Grandfather Leo Love was born. I was told in Birmingham, AL. However, the 1920 Census for Jefferson Co., AL gives his birthplace as Tennessee. (Note: as of June 2003, my aunt Carolyn tells me he was no doubt born in Birmingham, Jefferson Co., AL)

I and my cousins called my grandfather "Pappy Daddy" until we were older. Then he became Pap. I am told by my aunt Carolyn that he chose to be called "Pappy Daddy" after the comicstrip character Popeye's father "Poopdeck Pappy" because he didn't want to be called grandpa or granddaddy.

He was a man of great character. He worked as a railroad engineer all of his life and could not have had much money, especially raising eight kids. Nevertheless, he and his family would take Christmas gifts to the Orphanage every Christmas, and he would give good donations to Father Flanagan's Home for Boys every year until the day he died. I suppose he, and my grandmother, did this because my grandmother had spent part of her own childhood in an orphanage. After Pap's death my grandmother received a letter of condolence from Father Flanagan's Home.

My grandfather was a small man who had a very large spirit. Now that I know his heritage, I can understand why. He expressed that tremendous Welsh intensity through his own character.

Leo became ill in 1954. I was devastated. I loved him so much and wanted him to be present when I graduated from High School so I prayed night after night for him to live. He lived to witness my graduation from high

school in June of 1955. He died 1 December 1955. I still miss him, and have so many wonderful memories about him, after almost fifty years.

Miriam Estelle Brown was born 6 August 1892 in Milledgeville, GA. When she was three years old her father, Gerald, died of Tuberculosis which he had contracted in the Cotton Mill where he worked.

Her mother, Catherine died when she was six years old from the same disease. She and her sister Myrtis were taken in by an aunt to live with her and her husband.

The aunt and uncle were the girl's caretakers until they, themselves, both died in a fire in the bar he owned. I was told by my mother that Estelle was about seven or eight when this occurred. Mother said that the uncle was an alcoholic and would come home drunk and beat the aunt and the children so they would hide in the woods until he was asleep. After the death of the aunt and uncle, both girls were placed in the "Mumford Home for Children" in Milledgeville until they were each adopted. The story is that Myrtis was adopted first and, on the way home with her new parents, tried to tell them she had a sister at the orphanage. When they realized what she was saying, they turned around and went back to adopt Estelle also. By the time they arrived, Estelle had already been adopted by another couple. The two adoptive couples made an agreement to have the sisters visit each other as often as possible. Estelle was raised in Americus, GA.

When Estelle was sixteen my grandfather Leo Love entered her life. They were soon married in abt. 1908. Their first child, May E. Love was born. May lived until she was eighteen months old, at which time she died of colitis in her father's arms. They then had Leona, Gladys and a son whom they named Shelby. Shelby was stillborn. After the death of Shelby, their lives became happier. They had seven surviving children and later adopted another.

We called my grandmother Estelle, "Mama Love", and that she was. She was the most loving and compassionate human being I have known in my life. She was my role model for goodness.

My grandfather, Leo, died December of 1955 after which time she was never as happy for she never got over his death. She contracted a virus from a blood transfusion after having had a heart attack and died a painful death at the age of 84, twenty years after Leo's death.

" I went to Auburn for a quarter, in the NROTC. Meanwhile, I was waiting for appointments to either Annapolis Naval Academy, or to Kings Point, Merchant Marine Academy. I received appointments to both, and chose Kings Point.

Kings Point had a program where the entire sophomore year was spent in training on many different ships, whereas Annapolis only spent a quarter/year on one ship. This way, I traveled around the world on many different ships. Naturally, we did not have summer breaks the other three years to get the heavy curriculum completed. I was graduated in 1957 from Kings Point with a Mechanical Engineering degree, a commission of Ensign in the Navy, and an Engineers license for the Merchant Marine. This was in Long Island, NY.

I sailed on my license as an engineer on a passenger-cargo ship from New Orleans, LA to Europe. After one year, I was called into active duty in the Navy, stationed in Charleston, SC and Panama City, FL. I was assigned as the Operations Officer on an Ocean going MINE SWEEPER. That was a wonderful time for me also (1957-1959). We went on maneuvers off the coast of Florida until we were called to duty in the Mediterranean Sea, with the home port of Athens, Greece. Loved it. Never saw any action, since only the Lebanon crises was happening. I missed the Korean war (thankfully) with exemptions of being at the Academy; and, Viet Nam with exemptions for the moon landing program.

When I returned home after my tour of duty in the Navy in 1959, my Dad had a job possibility for me at Redstone Arsenal in Huntsville, AL. I checked it out and was hired as an engineer assigned to the Arsenal. The Army was developing the Redstone Rocket that was used for the early low altitude space flights with the monkeys, and later the Mercury Redstone program for the Astronauts. Then, NASA took over the Arsenal and it became Marshall Space Flight Center, as you know. I loved this period of time, too. President Kennedy made his famous announcement of a man on the moon, AND BACK SAFELY, this decade. I worked in the Quality & Reliability Engineering Program, with many of the German scientists, testing the systems of the emerging Saturn Flight Vehicle that eventually sent the men to the moon, and back, SAFELY, in the Apollo program.

In the latter part of 1968, I started to venture into inner space, as did so many of us after the successful moon landing. This is where I met my teacher, a magnificent woman teaching the Path of the Masters. She had been working for NASA as Administrative Assistant to Werner Von Braun, and left that life to concentrate on the inner (self) work. We developed a group of people who had the same drive in those days. (Source: Trevor Teague Mordecai, 2001)
