Reports are that Mr. Rowell asked Cave to go home when the youth hit at the officer who threw up his arm where the blows fell. The officer was taken to the office of Dr. M. Phelps who cared for the hurts.

Cave was arrested a short while afterward by Charles G Mudd, night peace officer, and lodged in jail on a cutting and wounding charge. He was released on bond Wednesday at his examining trial.

Intervention by W. L. Thomas who witnessed the conflict, prevented the officer from shooting Cave who was only a few feet away at the time Rowell drew his gun. The trouble occurred at the corner of R. L. Moorman's Drug Store and was witnessed by several persons.
